FICTION CALL NUMBER: This is assigned by the ACQ department and will be one of the following:

FIC

Author's last name or if there is no author use the first word of the title

SF

Author's last name or if there is no author use the first word of the title

M

Author's last name or if there is no author use the first word of the title

W

Author's last name or if there is no author use the first word of the title

COLLECTION CODE: This is determined by the selector when ordering. "New" collection codes ie. BBXF result in a blue dot on the pocket.

Hardcover books with no dust jacket:

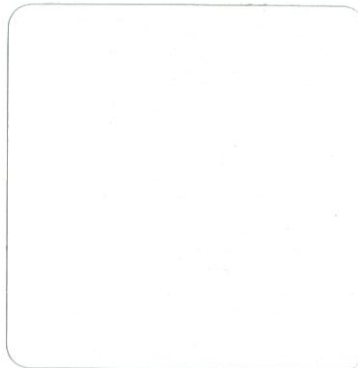
1. A large property label will be attached to bottom third of the title page adjusted to avoid covering pertinent information.

2. The barcode is placed in the upper right corner of the inside back cover.



3. The beeper is placed on the inside back cover where the pocket pouch will be.



4. The book pocket is centered 1 inch from the bottom of the inside back cover.

5. A large property label is centered on the pouch of the pocket.

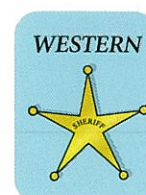
8. The rotation schedule is determined by the ACQ department and appears immediately above the pocket pouch and on a book card inserted in the pocket.

9. If the book is not to be rotated the branch code and the date processed (1st or 15th) appear immediately above the pocket pouch.

10. If the book has no genre label the spine label will be affixed ¼ inch from the bottom of the spine. If there is a genre label (Mystery, Science Fiction, Fantasy or Western) the genre label goes ¼ inch from the bottom of the spine with the spine label above it. Spine labeling is covered with book tape.

Hardcover books with a dust jacket: (see materials examples above)

1. A large property label will be attached to bottom third of the title page adjusted to avoid covering pertinent information.
2. The barcode is placed in the upper left corner of the inside back flyleaf.
3. The beeper is placed on the inside back flyleaf where the pocket pouch will be.
4. The book pocket is centered 1 inch from the bottom of the inside back flyleaf.
5. A large property label is centered on the pouch of the pocket.
6. If the item has a new collection code, a blue dot is placed in the bottom right corner of the pocket.
7. The bib label is centered flush with the top edge of the pocket.
8. The rotation schedule appears immediately above the pocket pouch and on a book card inserted in the pocket.
9. If the book is not to be rotated the branch code and the date processed (1st or 15th) appear immediately above the pocket pouch.
10. If the book has no genre label the spine label will be affixed ¼ inch from the bottom of the spine directly on the dust jacket. If there is a genre label (Mystery, Science Fiction, Fantasy or Western) the genre label goes ¼ inch from the bottom of the spine directly on the dust jacket with the spine label above it.
11. The dust jacket is covered with a mylar jacket and affixed with ¼ inch filament tape.

Paperback books: (see materials examples above)

1. A large property label will be attached to bottom third of the title page adjusted to avoid covering pertinent information.
2. The barcode is placed in the upper right corner of the inside back cover.
3. The beeper is placed on the inside back cover where the pocket pouch will be.
4. The book pocket is centered 1 inch from the bottom of the inside back cover.
5. A large property label is centered on the pouch of the pocket.
6. If the item has a new collection code, a blue dot is placed in the bottom right corner of the pocket.
7. The bib label is centered flush with the top edge of the pocket.
8. The branch code and the date processed (1st or 15th) appear immediately above the pocket pouch.
9. If the book has no genre label the spine label will be affixed ¼ inch from the bottom of the spine. If there is a genre label (Mystery, Science Fiction, Fantasy or Western) the genre label goes ¼ inch from the bottom of the spine with the spine label above it. The entire spine is covered with book tape.
10. 3 pieces of hinge tape (1/4 inch filament tape) 1 ½ to 2 inches in length are applied between the first page and the front cover. The same will be done for the last page and the back cover.

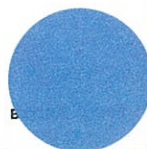
