

## Holding Record

### Juvenile Books on CD

11/30/09

**ITYPE:** All Juvenile Books on CD will come from HQ with the Itype BLJMN. This will be changed by VLC to BLJM nine months after the item is added to Horizon.

**FICTION CALL NUMBER:** This is assigned by Baker & Taylor or the ACQ department according to the ANSCR code. There is no “J” prefix.

**NON-FICTION CALL NUMBER:** This is assigned by Baker & Taylor or the ACQ department according to the Dewey Decimal System. There is a “J” prefix.

**COLLECTION CODE:** This is determined by the selector when ordering. “New” collection codes ie. BBXJBCD will result in a blue dot with the number representing the month processed.

**CHECK-IN NOTE:** This is entered in the holding record by Baker & Taylor or the ACQ department if the item has more than 1 CD or a combination of CDs, DVDs and booklets. It will be printed on the bibliographic label. *It should not be deleted.*

### Front of Case:

1. The bibliographic label will be attached to the front insert in the upper L corner. The label will be covered by a yellow C-View (1 ¼ X 3 1/8). If there are 2 or more CDs this will be noted on the label.

2. A small property label will be attached to the front insert in the lower L corner. Placement may be adjusted to avoid covering pertinent information as long as it remains at the bottom. Labels can be obtained from supply at HQ.

### Back of Case:

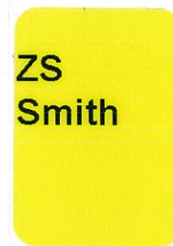
1. The barcode will be attached to the back insert at the top L corner. Placement may be adjusted to avoid covering pertinent information as long as it remains at the top.

2. The date due label will be attached to the back of the case along the left side vertically. Placement may be adjusted to avoid covering pertinent information.

**Spine Label:**

1. The spine label will be attached at the bottom of the spine on the insert. It will be covered vertically by a yellow C-View (7/8 X 1 ¼).



2. Books on CD with a “new” collection code ie. BBXJBCD will have a blue dot with the number representing the month processed attached just below the cutter on the spine label. The blue dot will be on top of the yellow C-view. “New” collection codes are assigned by the selector when ordering.



**Disc(s):**

1. Each disc will have a hub label with the agency code and barcode printed on it.

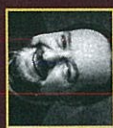

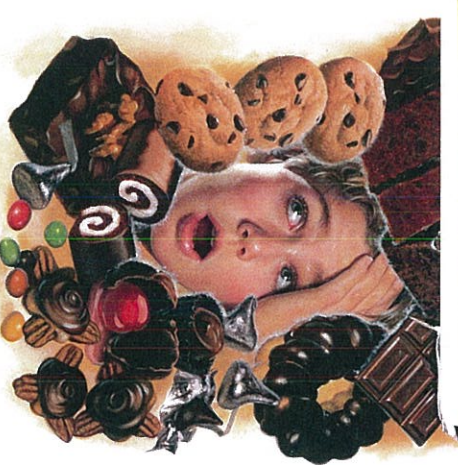

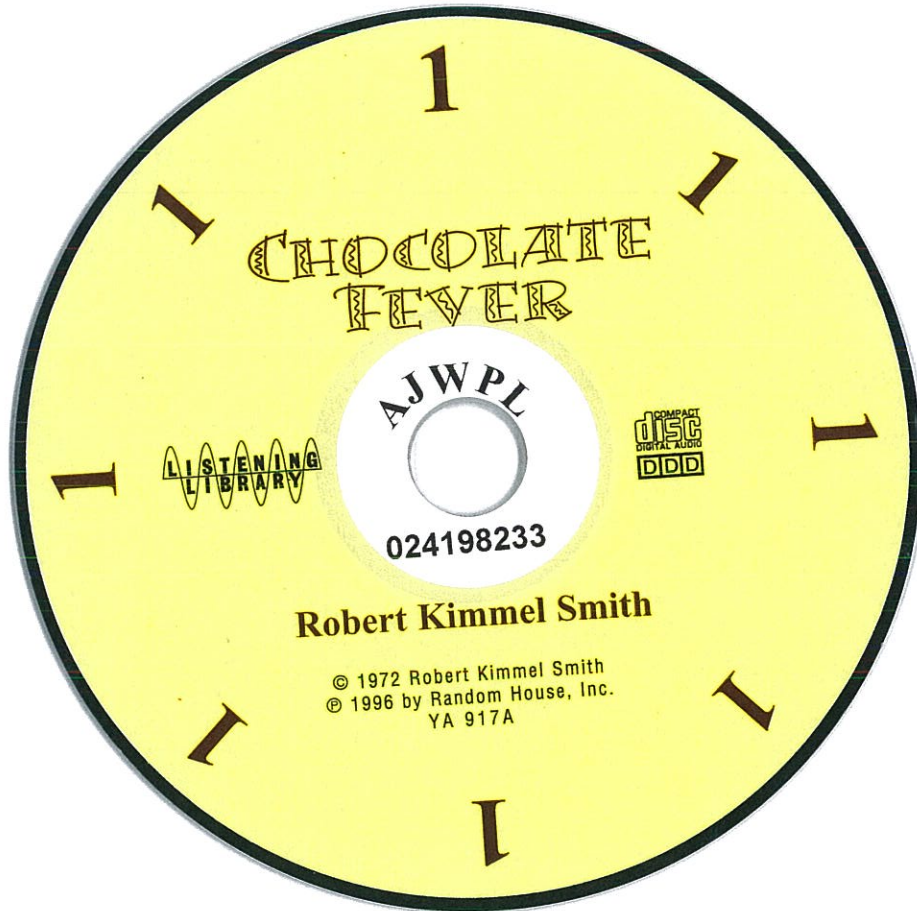
