Teen Books on CD

ITYPE: All Teen Books on CD will come from HQ with the Itype BLMN. This will be changed by VLC to BLM nine months after the item is added to Horizon.

FICTION CALL NUMBER: This is assigned by Baker & Taylor or the ACQ department according to the ANSCR code. There is a “Teen” prefix.

NON-FICTION CALL NUMBER: This is assigned by Baker & Taylor or the ACQ department according to the Dewey Decimal System. There is a “Teen” prefix.

COLLECTION CODE: This is determined by the selector when ordering. There are no “new” collection codes for Teen Books on CD.

CHECK-IN NOTE: This is entered in the holding record by Baker & Taylor or the ACQ department if the item has more than 1 CD or a combination of CDs, DVDs and booklets. It will be printed on the bibliographic label. *It should not be deleted.*

1. The bibliographic label will be attached to the front insert in the upper L corner. If there are 2 or more CDs this will be noted on the label.

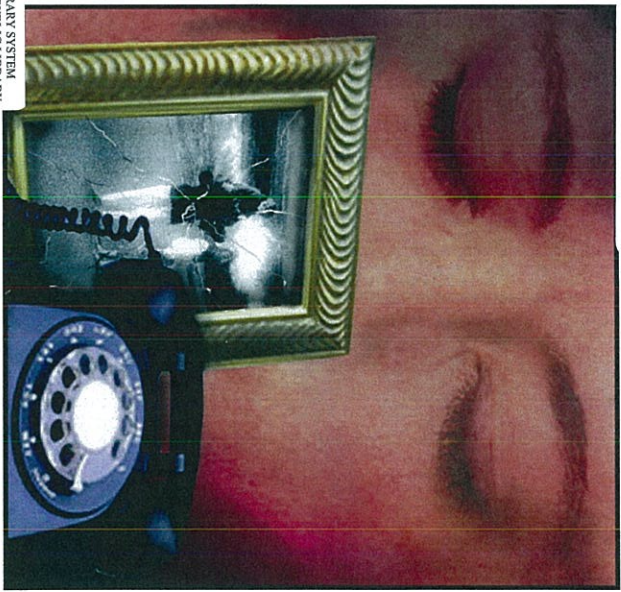
